



## DeStASH ScarF the Synnøve Way

I, like many other knitters, have a lot of yarn lying around in the house. Many times I buy yarn without a faintest idea of what I would like to do with it. In desperate need for new summer cotton scarves, I decided to knit just that. But I did not have enough yarn to knit one that will go twice around my neck. So I decided to add a sleeve at the end. This way I can put the scarf twice around my neck and finally slip the end of the scarf through the sleeve. Voila. I myself, love the result, and I will for sure knit more of these .

### **Yarn:**

Fresco cotton from Wisdom Yarns (DK / 8 ply, 100 meters/50g)

Petunia from Per Tryving (DK / 8 ply, 110 meters/50g)

### **Needles:**

7 mm

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## Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

st= stitch

k=knit

k2tog= knit 2 st together

yo= yarn over

yo2= yarn over twice

sl= slip stitch

wyf= with working yarn in front

wyb= with working yarn in back

## Pattern:

CO 21 st with one strand of each yarn.

Row 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 : Slip 1 st as if to knit, knit the rest of the st.

Row 7: k1, yo2, \*k1, yo\* repeat from \* to \* end with k1

Row 8: Knit st and slip the yo when you pass them.

Next rows: knit until you see 3 ridges at each side (= 5 more knit rows)

Repeat row 7 and 8.

Continue until you have just a small amount of yarn left.

Now the sleeve at the end.

Sleeve row 1: \*k1, sl 1 wyf,\* repeat from \* to \*and end with k1

Sleeve row 2: \*k1, sl1wyb\* repeat from \* to \* and end with k1

Continue working sleeve row 1 and 2 until you have about 1 m of yarn left.

K2tog,\* k2tog, pass the stich from the first k2tog over the last k2tog\* repeat from \* to \* and end with k 1, pass the last k2tog over that stich. You have now bound off your scarf. Weave in the ends and you are ready to go.
